- There is support for the collection and use of community engagement and public service data from institutional leaders in a variety of positions throughout campus (e.g. Academic Affairs, Student Affairs, President or Provost)
- There are open channels of communication throughout the institution for data collection and use as it relates to institutional planning, assessment, accreditation, research, etc.

AVAILABLE RESOURCES & SUPPORT

- A Core Administrator with expertise and experience in community engagement and data use has been identified to lead rollout, implementation, and use of Collaboratory on campus and has a dedicated amount of time to spend on such endeavors
- The Core Administrator is supported by a team of individuals (faculty, staff, and/or students) across campus to assist with Collaboratory implementation and data use
